## Internships

Job candidates with career-related experience receive more interviews, multiple job offers and higher starting salaries than candidates without experience. Build professional skills by securing an internship and earn academic credit, either through your department or through our own MSU 339 experiential education course.



## Document reviews

How you appear on paper is just as important as how you appear in person. At Career Services, we will partner with you to construct strong professional documents and correspondence, such as resumes, cover letters, graduate school applications and personal statements.
