Associate degree: For a second associate degree, the student must:

1. Hold an associate or higher degree from an accredited college or university.
2. Complete a program of study approved by the program advisor, department chair, or associate dean including at least 16 new semester hours (at least 12 must be earned at Morehead State University). At least 9 of the 16 semester hours earned must be in courses in a different associate degree program.
3. Earn a minimum 2.0 grade point average for all course work presented to complete the first associate degree, in all course work completed at Morehead State University, and all course work in the second associate degree program.

Bachelor's Degree: For a second bachelor's degree, the student must:

1. Hold a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university.
2. Complete a program of study approved by the program advisor, department chair or associate dean, including at least 32 new semester hours earned at Morehead State University. Of the 32 hours, a minimum of 15 semester hours must be earned in a second major or area of concentration.
3. Earn a minimum of 2.0 grade point average for all course work presented to complete the second degree, in all course work at Morehead State University, and in all course work in a major, minor, or area.

Master's Degree: To complete a second master's degree, a student must:

1. Meet Graduate School admission and candidacy requirements as well as department candidacy requirements;
2. Complete a minimum of 15 semester hours of University residence credit in approved courses; (Additional courses may be necessary to meet the degree requirements.)
3. Meet departmental exit criteria.
