

## Transfer Students

1. Full unconditional admission to MSU.
2. In addition to transcripts sent to MSU, an additional copy must also be submitted to the VT program. (The VT copy does not have to be an official transcript, copies are accepted.)
3. Acceptance into the VT program is based on your GPA, available seats in the program, documented veterinary work experience and PACHA health form/vaccinations.
4. Must maintain a minimum 2.8 overall GPA in college level courses with a 2.6 in Math, Biology, and Chemistry. Grades in Math, Biol and Chem must be 'C' or above.
5. You must complete Math 131 or higher, Biology 160 or 171, and Chemistry 101 (including lab) or courses equivalent to MSU classes.
6. You must complete a minimum of 120 hrs of supervised work with a veterinarian before acceptance into the program (VT sequence), and submit a completed work experience form.
7. Submit and complete all medical documentation by the end of the first week of the fall semester in which you start the Vet Tech program.
8. Documentation of Pre-Exposure Rabies Vaccine. (Please note that the cost of the series of 3 vaccinations is very expensive. Check with your insurance company for possible coverage. The estimated cost of the three shot series is \$900.00).
9. Counseling and Health Services can give you all of your required immunizations; however, you may obtain your immunizations at your primary physician. If you choose to receive the immunizations at your primary physician you will need to submit official documentation to the University Counseling and Health Clinic in order to obtain immunization compliance for the clinical (lab) portion of the veterinary technology program.
