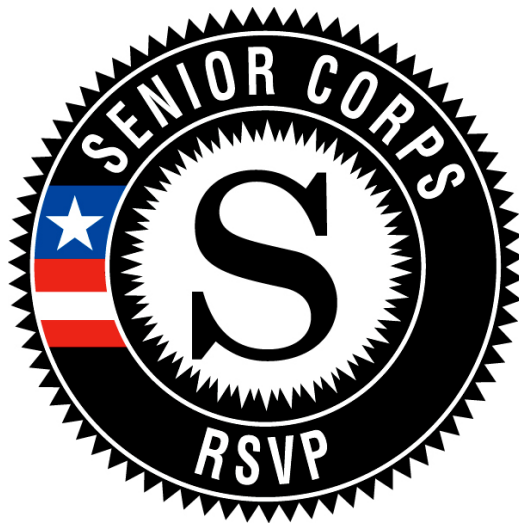

Morehead State University Retired and Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP) received a Senior Corps RSVP grant from the Corporation for National and Community Service (CNCS) to support volunteers serving in Boyd, Carter, Elliott, Greenup and Lawrence counties. The funds were awarded as part of a Senior Corps grant competition to expand RSVP to new geographic areas. The MSU RSVP currently serves Bath, Menifee, Montgomery, Morgan and Rowan counties. The new grant will expand services into Boyd, Carter, Elliott, Greenup and Lawrence counties.

As part of this grant's mission, MSU's RSVP has partnered with Lawrence County Schools to provide curriculum and volunteers to implement an opioid abuse prevention program for 3- 8th grade students. To assist Lawrence County Schools with their goal of implementing the program this school year. According to Lawrence County Schools Superintendent Robbie Fletcher, "The Lawrence County Board of Education set forth an expectation that we increase our efforts in educating children about drug abuse prevention. This partnership not only allows us to meet that expectation but also provides our teachers with valuable resources. We are very excited about this opportunity."

New Volunteer Betty Fossett

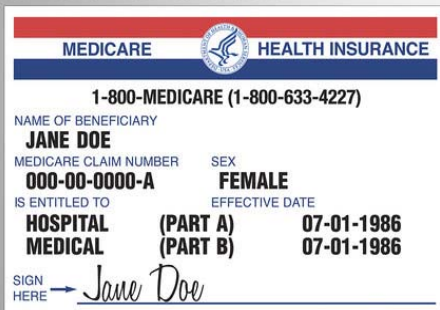

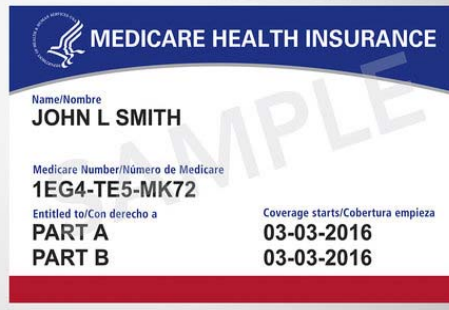

You're getting a new Medicare card! Cards will be mailed between April 2018–April 2019. You asked, and we listened. You're getting a new Medicare card! Between April 2018 and April 2019, Social Security will be removing Social Security numbers from Medicare cards and mailing each person a new card. This will help keep your information more secure and help protect your identity. You'll get a new Medicare Number that's unique to you, and it will only be used for your Medicare coverage. The new card won't change your coverage or

benefits. You'll get more information from Medicare when your new card is mailed.
